

PROTOCOLS FOR RE-OPENING ALTON LITTLE THEATER

Front & Back of House staffed with ALT Board Members & Limited Volunteers

UNIVERSAL MASKING (masks provided if necessary). * Performers are masked during rehearsals and ONLY perform 8 times without masks after daily temperature checks and isolation with Cast “Pod”

SOCIAL DISTANCING with Poster Signage everywhere and RED-LINE/ RESTRICTED SEATING by Reservation & Re-mapping of the 10,000 square foot Theater Auditorium

THE ALT SHOWPLACE IS PROFESSIONALLY CLEANED TWICE before each show opens and then a Comprehensive Misting and Cleaning are done by the House Manager and staff after each and every performance

EIGHT NEW TOUCHLESS SANITIZERS are installed in every area of the building for use

NO PROGRAMS, TICKETS OR PAPERS are distributed and there is a “Ticketless” Reservation System in place

NO CONGRAGATING WILL BE ALLOWED: NO beverages or snacks will be available AND Guests can of course, use restrooms (which will be monitored for Social Distancing); Guests may bring bottled water with them and/or purchase small bottles from gloved staff at a single window for \$1

THERE ARE SEPARATE ENTRANCES AND EXITS AND ADDITIONAL HANDICAPPED ENTRANCES AND EXITS WHICH ARE IN CLOSE PROXIMITY!

ALT WILL CONTINUE TO COORDINATE SAFETY PRECAUTIONS WITH LOCAL AUTHORITIES AND THE GOVERNOR’S OFFICE OF CONSTIUENT ADVOCACY
